**Update:** Numerous tips were rapidly sent to KCSO following our release of a missing person, Rodney Griffin Jr. Griffin was spotted by several people in the Charleston area which led us to the Charleston Police Department for assistance. CPD confirmed they had recent interactions with Griffin, provided us with his location and acknowledged that he is safe.



## **MISSING PERSON**

### **Griffin Jr., Rodney Linell**

Male, black, 35 years old

5'8", 160 lbs.

Black hair, brown eyes

Deputy C.S. Sigmon with the Kanawha County Sheriff's Office is seeking assistance locating the above missing person.

Rodney Linell Griffin Jr. is an adult male resident of Kanawha County. His family last heard from him on October 31, 2024, during the evening hours. Rodney is believed to be in possession of his cell phone; however, he has been unreachable. Rodney's family says his disappearance is uncharacteristic of him and they are concerned about his well-being. Rodney was last seen wearing gray sweatpants and a white T-shirt. He has two prosthetic legs and both hands have been amputated. Rodney is not believed to be in any danger currently but does have some medical conditions.
