Kanawha County, WV – As heavy rainfall and unseasonal thunderstorms swept through the Kanawha Valley, rising floodwaters created dangerous conditions for residents, leading to numerous emergency calls to Metro 911. Kanawha County Sheriff's Deputies worked tirelessly throughout the night and into the following day, responding to calls for flood rescues, stranded motorists, and trapped residents.

One particularly **heroic rescue effort** involved **Deputy T.A.
